- Innovation-led companies are asked to forecast and share their current and future property needs to help shape the city's future.




Sheffield Innovation Spine

Innovation companies seeking space in the city centre can voluntarily submit their forecasts through three webforms:

- Company details
- Lab requirements
- Office requirements

Initial data submission should take 20-30 minutes.

You will be asked to periodically check these forecasts – e.g. every 6 months.



Managing and using your data

- We will use your data to produce anonymised reports and data dashboards to inform public and private decision makers.
- If your company identifies a short term need then, with your permission, we may introduce you to the support available from the Business Sheffield team.

Your data will be stored under the data protection policy of Sheffield Technology Parks.

By making a submission you are granting permission for your data to be shared with the Sheffield Innovation Spine partners (Sheffield Technology Parks, University of Sheffield, Sheffield City Council, Sheffield Hallam University and South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority).








Innovation companies seeking space in the city centre can voluntarily submit their forecasts through three webforms:
